Mwangaza Education for Partnership is a grassroots, faith-based organization that fosters a variety of learning programs for secondary school teachers and students, women’s groups, and congregational leaders. Mwangaza works in 21 dioceses of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Tanzania (ELCT) and responds to their requests for professional development, community health, and women’s advocacy seminars. Participants are actively engaged in seminar activities, thereby empowered to return to their communities and train others. They pass on their knowledge and teaching skills, resulting in stronger, healthier communities.

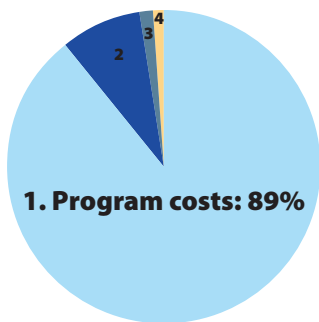
